

Prof Dato Dr Mohd Azemi Mohd Noor

Prof Dato Dr Mohd Azemi Mohd Noor was awarded PhD by The University of New South Wales, Sydney Australia in 1985. He served Universiti Sains Malaysia (USM) for 26 years and subsequently in 2004 was seconded to Universiti Kuala Lumpur (UniKL) as a Dean at UniKL Malaysia Institute of Chemical Engineering Technology. At USM Prof Azemi was the sole occupant of Kuok Foundation Professorial Chair in Food Science and Technology and had also served as Dean School of Industrial Technology, USM. From 2006 to 2013 Prof Azemi served as UniKL's Deputy President (Academic and Technology) and currently as a Senior Professor at UniKL Malaysia Institute of Chemical Engineering Technology.

Prof Azemi has also served as a Visiting Professor at Virginia Polytechnic and State University (USA), Kyoto University (Japan) and Kazakh Agrotechnical University (Kazakhstan).

As a researcher, Prof Azemi published extensively in many international refereed journal and had also been invited to speak at various international and national conferences. Prof Azemi research interest are in the area of agriculture wastes utilisation and in particular starch and cellulose technology.

Prof Azemi had also received several international awards in recognition for his expertise and scientific contributions: The USDA Cochrane Award, Commonwealth Award, Japanese Scientific and Promotion of Science, Asian Development Bank Award and Senior Molton Award (UK).
